Also, the SCCF will fund one \$1,000 youth scholarship to a college student (Freshman- Senior) whose intent is to pursue a four-year degree in a curriculum that is non-agricultural.

The SCCF will fund one \$1,000 youth scholarship to a student whose intent is to pursue a two-year degree in applied agricultural sciences or a non-agricultural field.
