The **South Carolina Cattlemen's Foundation** will fund one \$2,000 youth scholarship and one \$1,000 scholarships to a Freshmen-Senior college student whose intent is to pursue a four-year degree in a curriculum of applied agricultural sciences (major codes 100 at Clemson). Applications will be considered in the following areas, in order of importance: 1) agricultural background and related activities, 2) scholastic achievement and 3) financial need.

The **SCCF** will also fund one \$2,000 youth scholarship and one \$1,000 scholarships to a Freshmen-Senior college student whose intent is to pursue a four year degree, with no restriction on the field of study. Applications will be considered with emphasis on the following areas, in order: 1) scholastic achievement, 2) financial need and 3) agricultural background and related activities.

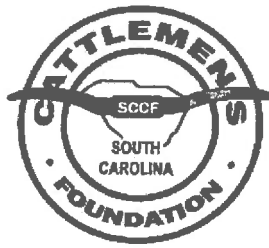
